听下面 5 段对话。每段对话后有一个小题,从题中所给的 A、B、C 三个选项中选出最佳选项,并标在试卷的相应位置。听完每段对话后,你都有 10 秒钟的时间来回答有关小题和阅读下一小题。每段对话仅读一遍。

1. M: Good afternoon, San Felice Hotel. May I help you?

W: Yes. I'd like to book a room, please. I'd appreciate it if you could give me a room with a view over the lake.

2. W: Wow, you look like a drowned rat! Didn't you know there's a thunderstorm today?

M: I knew there would be a shower, but it is raining cats and dogs.

3. M: Did you say you were going to take a vacation next week?

W: I was planning to take it at the end of this week. My husband and I haven't had a chance to have a vacation over the past three years. So we are planning to travel to Europe this time.

4. W: Hi, Adam! How are you?
