听下面 5 段对话。每段对话后有一个小题,从题中所给的 A、B、C 三个选项中选出最佳选项。听完每段对话后,你都有 10 秒钟的时间来回答有关小题和阅读下一小题。每段对话仅读一遍。

1. W: What do you do in your spare time?

M: Listening to music, reading books, watching movies and so on. But I like playing football best.

2. M: Let me ask you a few questions, Lisa. What is your major and do you have any working experience before?

W: I major in electric engineering and I have worked in a company for 3 years.

3. W: Robin, what time do you want me to wake you up tomorrow morning? At 7:30 as usual?

M: Mom, please wake me up 30 minutes earlier. I will go to the museum with Steve at 8:00 in the morning.

W: OK. Got it.

4. M: Excuse me, Madam. I'd like to choose some flowers to send to my mother.

W: Let's see. These fresh roses are very nice and cheap too.

M: OK. I'll take these roses.

5. W: I was reading some news about the fires in the forest. The fires have been spreading for several days and they still haven't been put out yet.

M: The fires make me worried, too.

第二节
